Jan 22, 1973 -Roe v Wade: Established by the Federal government a right to abortion, **meaning all states were MANDATED** (Forced) to allow abortion access. How did we get here? I am sure the German people asked the same thing, (HOLOCAUST). Since the Dobbs decision (June 24th 2022) the Supreme court ruled that the Constitution does not grant a right to abortion, and the authority to regulate abortion is returned to the people and their elected representatives. Since the Dobbs decision, currently there are nine pro-choice states that have **NO restrictions** based on how far along a woman is in her pregnancy. Fourteen pro-life states have banned abortion with few exceptions. The remainder of the states ban abortion from 6 weeks up to the third trimester. Washington State: Abortion ban 24-26 weeks. Numbers taken from guttmacher.org, this organization is pro-choice.
