Washington Alliance for Life would like to respond to an interview The News Tribune and a spokesperson from the WSF had on August 14th . It was reported that Washington Alliance had a graphic display. Washington Alliance for Life response: We support the unborn and are a Human Life-Pro family nonprofit organization. We have never displayed any graphic displays in our booths either in brochures, banners or with the developing 'Unborn Life touch baby models'.

Washington Alliance For Life has participated at the WSF Fair since 2013. Educating with Banners, Brochures and The Touch of Life baby models of which is human development at different stages of life, these same babies are shown in medical schools and many Biology and health classes across our country. Our second objective is help pregnant women who choose to have their baby but have "No community". WAFL Resource Brochures for pregnant women are available in English, Spanish & Russian. Non-profit organizations, located in Pierce County are eager to help pregnant women that are seeking help. These pro-family organizations are listed in the Washington Alliance For Life Brochure.

Washington Alliance for Life has never participated in "Street protests", or have "graphic" signage or displays as the spokesperson implied. I believe there has been a miscommunication with Stacy Van Horn, as I met with the WSF Board on August 14th and we were kindly welcomed back :) I was asked at the Board Meeting for the first time if we would not display the 16 week to 26 week baby models. The reason being that this has triggered some women that have had an abortion. I hesitated, making this decision as I love it when the kids run up to our booth and say "look mommy!" However, my heart goes out to these women that have gone through this. I just spoke to the area coordinator for 'Healing Hearts', listed in our brochure that offer post abortion counseling for men and women.
